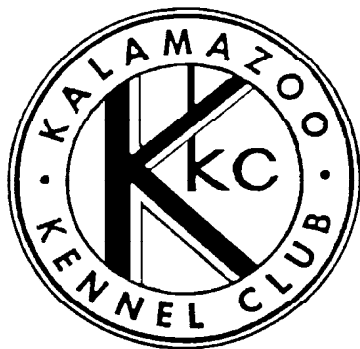

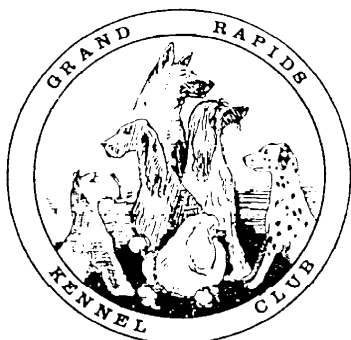

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Rules Applying to Dog Shows • Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

SHOW HOURS EACH DAY • 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. - EST

Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. SHOW LOCATION IS AVAILABLE TO EXHIBITORS 1:00 P.M. ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2009

ENTRY FEES EACH DAY

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH DAY! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE DAY, ONLY THE FIRST DAY WILL BE PROCESSED!

ENTRY FEE is \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog, except in Puppy Classes & Bred by Exhibitor Classes which are \$24.00. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$23.00. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$10.00 as an Additional Entry; \$18.00 if entered for 'Junior Showmanship Only'. Obedience & Rally Entries are \$28.00 for the first entry of each dog & \$23.00 for each additional entry. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

ENTRIES CLOSE at Superintendent's Office, WEDNESDAY NOON (EDT), OCTOBER 21, 2009, unless limits have been reached prior to this date, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules or Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. OBEDIENCE & RALLY ENTRIES CLOSE at Superintendent's Office, WEDNESDAY NOON (EDT), OCTOBER 21, 2009, unless limits are reached prior to this date.

The Clinic is on the Left side of the Street.
